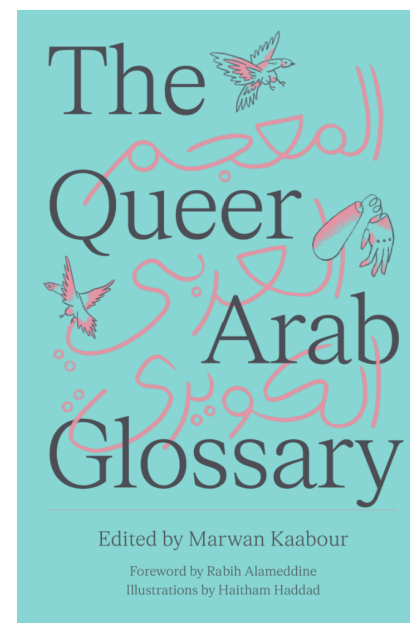

# MARWAN KAABOUR

IN CONVERSATION WITH

**Marwan Kaabour** is a graphic designer, artist and writer. His interdisciplinary practice builds pathways between communication and publication design, curation, pedagogy and political activism. In 2019, Marwan founded Takweer, an online platform and expanding archive of queer narratives in Arab history and popular culture. **Dina Georgis** is Associate Professor in the Women and Gender Studies Institute and the author of *The Better Story: Queer Affects from the Middle East* (SUNY, 2013), situated between postcolonial and sexuality studies. **Maya El Helou** is a PhD Candidate in the Department of Anthropology in a collaborative program with sexual diversity studies and a comic artist. Her dissertation, a sensory ethnography, tackles queer resistance in Beirut.
